

# **Senior Development Project Manager**

## **Job Summary:**

The Senior Development Project Manager will manage and oversee the entire real estate development process. This position will coordinate the work of the development team, serving as central point for communication and decision making between owners and the development team. As well as the duties described below, a key component of the position is owner interaction and therefore DaVinci seeks candidates with exceptional client, as well as, project management skills. ## **Description of Responsibilities:**

#### **General Duties:**

- Manage development projects from inception, through construction and occupancy
- Source, qualify, engage and manage architects, general contractors and other third-party consultants and vendors required to execute the owner's projects including managing the preconstruction, construction, completion and turnover of the projects to ownership and operations
- Lead and direct project pre-development and pre-construction activities on behalf of the owner including project architects and other consultants in the design of the project to meet the goals and objectives of the owner
- Manage the entitlement process, including obtaining all planning and permit approvals

#### Specific Responsibilities:

- Lead and collaborate with design professionals and consultants as well as with the owner to identify the project's goals and objectives, develop an initial project concept
- Assess project feasibility, creation of financial model through pro-forma analysis
- Oversee the preparation of initial development program and concept plan(s)
- Solicit proposals, evaluate and make recommendations for award for primary consultants as well as all sub-consultants
- Lead the preparation of development budgets and schedules to support the project(s) assigned and manage through project duration
- Assist with zoning, entitlements and other development approvals
- Coordinate design team presentations and coordinate and manage all changes to the design including proposed value engineering
- Make recommendations regarding all proposed changes to the design for client approval
- Review all design documents to ensure compliance with design directives and coordinate with owner to consolidate and communicate comments to design team

- Coordinate procurement method and construction contract
- Review and analyze all pre-construction data and develop a thorough understanding of the relationships between all aspects of the design and related costs
- Plan and lead all Owner/Architect/Contractor Meetings and communications
- Review and analyze all applications for payment and coordinate billing and payments measured against approved project budget
- Manage procurement and installation of related FF&E
- Manage project close out to ensure Owner is set up for on-going property management and operations
